### **Faculty Compensation Plan**

Department of Radiology and Biomedical Imaging faculty are members of the University of California Health Sciences Compensation Plan. Here are the benefits:

- 2 vacation days per month accumulated
- 20 meeting days per year to attend meetings, presentation, CME, etc
- 20% academic / non-clinical time [10% for HS Clinical Series]
- Clinical Bonus Plan Participants may receive incentive compensation, referred to as a Z payment, beyond the base and negotiated compensation, upon approval by the Chair. The bonus payments are drawn from income accumulated in the Plan in excess of financial requirements.

#### **Department Support**

The Department currently also offers full time faculty funding the following support:

### **UCSF FACULTY BENEFITS**

To aid in your transition to your faculty position, the Department will provide you with a recruitment allowance (signing bonus) through the UC Faculty Recruitment Allowance Program [FRAP]. You are eligible for FRAP if you are a full time faculty member (100%) with a Ladder Rank, In Residence, Clinical X, or Health Sciences Clinical Professor title.
