AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Shuttle Service: To reach the City from the San Francisco International Airport via Super Shuttle van service, exit the Airport Terminal on the ground level and follow the corresponding signs. Super Shuttles are blue & gold. The cost is \$16.00 each way from San Francisco Airport to a hotel destination.

A reservation is not needed for pickup. CASH OR CREDIT CARDS are accepted.

Note: Super Shuttle can also take you from the Oakland International Airport, located on the east side of San Francisco Bay, to the UCSF Parnassus Campus. The cost each way is \$25.00 and a reservation must be made one day prior to arrival and paid by credit card only.

Taxis are available directly in front of the airport exit doors.

The fare into San Francisco is approximately \$45 dollars.

BART (Bay Area Rapid Transit)

A new BART extension to San Francisco International Airport (SFO) airport was completed on June 22, 2003.

The cost is approximately \$5.00+ (*+ subject to change*). The travel time is approximately 45 minutes. Take BART to Civic Center. Change to the Muni-Metro N line to the Parnassus Campus. For complete information and train schedules, please go to the internet website: www.bart.gov

Attire: The weather in San Francisco is often cool, even in summer. It is best to be prepared for a variety of weather, and to dress in layers. Attire at the University is casual – although you may wear a tie if you prefer, polo shirts and slacks are appropriate for men, and slacks are fine for women.

Parking: Discounted parking stickers are available to Visiting Fellows in the UCSF Public Parking Garage at the rate of \$11.25 per day. It is not necessary to purchase stickers in advance; they can be purchased from Nancy Mutnick upon arrival. Enter the parking garage at either Parnassus Avenue or Irving Street entrance, and retain the parking ticket receipt issued by the machine. Please note that stickers are good for only one exit per day (no “in & out” privileges.)
