The Department of Radiology and Biomedical Imaging has provided each enrolled student with a laptop (MacBook Air, 4GB RAM, 128 GB hard drive) for use during the course of study in the Master of Science in Biomedical Imaging (MBI) program. This laptop is fully encrypted and is loaded with the software that is required during the course of the program. It is mandatory that the laptop be used only for educational purposes, to connect to the University resources and not to store any personal data. Personal computers should not be used in lieu of this laptop for course work. In addition, please refrain from using any portable devices (thumb drives, external hard drives, etc.) to store MBI data.

Upon completing the MBI program it is required that the laptop be returned in functioning condition to the IT desk. The Master's degree will not be conferred until this laptop is received and certified by the Department of Radiology and Biomedical Imaging's IT section. By signing below you agree to these terms.
